On August 31, 2001, Bill Cole, president of Audioscan, presented the staff at the new National Centre for Audiology, University of Western Ontario with the first Verifit model VF-1 to roll off the assembly line. This state-of-the-art clinical Real-Ear Hearing Aid Analyzer was jointly donated by Widex Canada and Audioscan for use in the Child Amplification Lab at the world-class facility in London Ontario. Featuring dual signal presentation and dual measurement channels, real speech test signals, powerful DSP analysis capabilities and special tests for directional hearing aids, the Verifit VF-1 represents a new level of sophistication in the testing and fitting of hearing instruments and assistive devices.
